

Edinburgh COVID-19 testing sites and vaccination clinic locations week beginning 21st February 2022

We are still encouraging those who have yet to receive their first dose or who are now due their second dose or booster of the COVID vaccine to come forward.

In line with national guidance, drop in sessions are also now open to those aged 12-15 who are 12 weeks since their first dose and have not had Covid-19 in the last 12 weeks.

1st, 2nd Dose and COVID Booster Vaccinations - Everyone over 12 can attend these drop-in clinic as well as utilising booked appointments:

- **Edinburgh International Conference Centre, The Exchange, 150 Morrison St, Edinburgh EH3 8EE. Open every day 8am-7pm.**
 - Please note the EICC will close at 5pm on Friday 25th February
- **Member's Pavillion Hall, Royal Highland Vaccination Centre, Ingliston Road, Ingliston, Newbridge EH28 8NB. Open every day 8am-7pm**

In addition to the mass vaccination centres, vaccinations are also available at the following sites:

The **vaccination trailer at Fort Kinnaird** is now open from **10.30am-3.45pm**, 7 days a week. The drop-in clinic is available for 12–17-year-olds who need to receive their 1st or 2nd dose or for those 18+ who need their 1st, 2nd or booster doses.

Asymptomatic Testing Sites

Testing for people with no COVID-19 symptoms – no appointment necessary

- **McDonald Library**, 2-8 McDonald Rd, Edinburgh EH7 4LU. **Open 9am-6pm until Saturday 26th February 2022 (closed Sundays)**. You can also pick up home testing kits here.
- **Blackhall Library**, 56 Hillhouse Road, Edinburgh, EH4 5EG. **Open 9am – 6pm until Saturday 26th February 2022 (closed Sundays)**. You can also pick up home testing kits here.

Mobile Testing Units

Mobile testing units are run by the Scottish Ambulance Service and offer PCR tests. You will be sent your result in 24 to 72 hours. These units are for people **with symptoms** and people **without symptoms**. If you have **no symptoms** you don't need to make an appointment. If you have symptoms you must book an appointment first.

- **Edinburgh University, Buccleuch Place** (outside Gordon Aikman Lecture Theatre), **until Sunday 27th February, 10am to 4pm.**
- **Saughton Park** (car park), Ford's Road, **until Sunday 27th February, 10am – 4pm.**
- **Craigmillar Medical Centre** (car park), 106 Niddrie Mains Road, **until Sunday 27th February, 10am to 4pm**
- **Forth Road Bridge Administration Office** (car park), South Queensferry, **until Sunday 27th February, 10am to 4pm**
- **Tumbles at Portobello** (car park), 20 Westbank Street, **until Sunday 27th February, 10am – 4pm.**
